Firstly a thank you must go out again to the volunteers who unselfishly give their time to come to the course to do many tasks which help keep the course in great condition.

Course improvements- this year has been the placement of the 120m cart path on the fourth hole.

Bunker management - new bunkers on the tenth hole and fifth fairway bunker. These bunkers we used the new Proline system which involves lining with blue metal aggregate covering with bitumen lining then with sand.

This system has been proven in heavy rains. There is little sand movement, thus little time is used to get them back into play, to this point in time is working very well.

The construction of the nineteenth green, a par 3. This green will be used when we commence our green replacements program, giving us a proper surface to play instead of a temporary green. It will also be used if the staff have to do work on a green and close it for the duration of work for their safety. Also replacement of the sixth tee. We releveled and resurfaced.

Machinery replacement this year we saw the purchase of a greens mower and a new work ute. Next year we have on the books replacement of the spray cart and utility buggy.
