Golf Shop Report

I find this option the best way to improve as we can work on different areas of the game each session and give you something to work on in between sessions.

PRO TIP – HANGING BACK

Hanging Back refers to a lack of weight shift towards the target on the downswing resulting in a weak impact position. From last month's tip (Impact Fix), the desired impact position is a downward strike on the ball with the club shaft leaning forward. Usually, the player is still on their back foot at impact (see picture). In a normal weight shift, the player is about four inches closer to the target at impact compared to address. Many times, the player will hit heavy divots that begin behind the ball, or they may have compensated with a ball position that is too far back in their stance. Hanging Back is a major cause of loss of speed since weight shift is one of the most important skills to help produce club head speed. Important Information for all Members

Membership Survey Responses and the Board's Decision

The Board recently put out a survey to all playing members to ascertain the memberships' interest in changing the membership categories to allow for 5 and 6 day playing memberships in addition to the existing 7 day membership. Only 15% of the playing membership responded by the deadline, however, we received a number of late survey results and these were included in the final analysis but the total responses received amounted to only 23.87% of surveys returned.

The results (as a percentage of the total surveys received) were as follows:

7 day membership	49%
Opposed to any change	14%
6 day membership	10%
5 day membership	22%
Undecided	5%

The board reviewed the results and considered that the majority of respondents were in favour of either 7 day memberships or were opposed to any change (63% in total). The board considered the fact that less than a quarter of the membership responded and therefore there was insufficient responses to ascertain how any change would affect the revenue raised from memberships and that the total revenue from memberships currently only covers 58% of the cost of maintaining the course. The board therefore decided that it was not in the best interest of the membership as a whole to introduce 5 and 6 day membership categories.

On the 21st November 2021 the results if the survey were presented to the members present at the AGM.
