

2022 Murwillumbah Men's Club Championships Conditions of Play

The men's club championships will be played over four consecutive rounds on the following dates:

Round 1 - Saturday 20 th August	Round 3 - Sunday 27 th August
Round 2 – Sunday 21 st August	Round 4 - Sunday 28 th August

The format of play will be 72 holes stroke play from the Blue Tees and eight major prizes will be awarded as follows:

72 Hole Gross Club Champion	(H'cap +5–10)
72 Hole B Grade Gross Champion	(Hcap 11-15)
72 Hole C Grade Gross Champion	(Hcap 16-20)
72 Hole D Grade Gross Champion	(Hcap 21-36)
72 Hole Overall Net Champion	(All grades)
72 Hole Junior Veterans Gross Club Champion	(55-64 years)
72 Hole Senior Veterans Gross Club Champion	(>65 years)
72 Hole Junior Gross Club Champion	(<18 years)

- Players will be able to pre-register their preferred tee times <u>for all four rounds</u> from Saturday 6th August at 5:00pm by entering their names on the timesheet (no prepayment required).
- If there is a tie for any gross event, there will be a 3-hole aggregate playoff from the 1st, 2nd and 3rd holes. If there is still a tie, the match committee will determine which hole to continue play sudden death from, until a winner is determined. Overall Net Champion will be decided on a countback over the last 18 holes.
- The top 4 gross players in each grade are highly encouraged to play in a seeded draw for the fourth round, although this is not compulsory. Tee times will be as follows: D Grade – 11:14, C Grade – 11:21, B Grade 11:28, A Grade – 11:35.
- The R&A Rules of Golf and local rules of Murwillumbah Golf Club shall be the rules of play for the event. The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather, change the competition conditions. Any rules questions should be directed to the Pro Shop by calling 6672 4200.
