The rain that we had throughout January seems to have eased during February but the humidity has been oppressive. Thankfully the air conditioning in the Club house has been keeping members comfortable and I hope that you all enjoyed a thirst quenching beverage or two.

The Government increased the excise tax on all alcoholic beverages at the beginning of February as did the suppliers of non-alcoholic beverages. However, due to prudent planning by our Secretary Manager, Gary Thatcher, we stocked up our supplies and have been able to delay the passing on of the increases until late in the month.

We have been paying close attention to news reports regarding fires started by lithium batteries and have been getting advice from our insurance brokers. To date the reports of such fires have not come from 2 seater golf carts with lithium batteries. The fires have started from chargers that do not cut the power supply when a battery is fully charged and this overheats the lithium batteries which then cause the fires. The 2 seater golf carts that are available for hire from the Club all have chargers that have been designed

to cut out when they reach full charge. Consequently, members that have lithium batteries in their single seat golf buggies and pull carts that are stored on club premises are required to remove the lithium battery after each round of golf and charge them off site.

Easter is just around the corner and will be here before we know it. Natasha has organized a very special magic show followed by the Easter bunny handing out free Easter Eggs for Saturday 23rd March. 
Newman's team included his son Luke, Les Gorton and Shane Kight. They scored 51 points after their handicaps had been deducted.

The late Robin Smith, 71, was a popular identity on the Tweed and died from heart trouble at Cabarita Beach on Monday, January 29.




He was a life member of the Tweed River Jockey Club where he served on the committee for about 15 years and a prominent footballer and committee man for the South Murwillumbah club.
