## Chairman's Corner

A number of members have advised that they are having difficulties in getting a tee time on the Saturday and sometimes on the Wednesday competitions, this in part is due to the shorter daylight hours during winter as well as a growing membership base. At the July Board meeting the Board decided to freeze playing memberships while we consider a range of options that may address this problem. However, we will keep the junior membership category open as juniors do not have an impact on the playing fields and it is important for our future that we encourage young people into the game of golf. We will introduce the changes that we believe will assist in addressing the problem on a trial basis for three months and seek member feedback on such changes.

At the time of writing we are awaiting detailed cost estimates of the proposed options for the new cart sheds and parking areas that are proposed to be located on the existing driving range area. When we receive these costings we will provide members with detailed plans and place them on the notice Board at the Club for all to see. A members meeting will then be called so that the Board can receive feedback from members. While the planned changes will reduce the driving range area, rest assured that they will also incorporate sufficient areas for both long-range, short-range and bunker practicing areas. As you are all aware the internal areas of the golf club are limited and therefore, it will be necessary for members that wish to attend the meeting to provide an RSVP. If the number of members that wish to attend exceed the Club house capacity it will be necessary to schedule the meeting at another facility that can accommodate those that wish to attend.

In last months newsletter I advised that playing members would soon receive a letter from the club advising that they need to provide evidence of adequate insurance, in particular public liability insurance, for the use of personal golf carts and bikes on Club premises. It will be necessary for anyone who utilises a cart or bike on the course to have the insurance policy endorsed stating that Murwillumbah Golf Club Ltd is an interested party. The need to provide this insurance coverage applies to all carts and bikes regardless of their power source, it is not just applicable to lithium powered items. As stated previously the Board and management have made enquiries about providing a blanket insurance policy for our members but have not been able to secure such insurance as everyone's carts are of differing brands, models, ages, power sources and maintenance history. This requirement will apply to every privately owned cart used on the course whether it is stored at the Club or not.

Murwillumbah Mens Division 1 Pennant Team 1981

Competing in the Gold Coast (GCDGA) and Northern Rivers (NRDGA) Division 1 pennant competitions it had been some 30 years since Murwillumbah had won a pennant and dare I say it in the prior years very few team victories were recorded let alone making a final. This year however the team clicked and started a run of pennant wins including wins in both the GCDGA and NRDGA zones in 1981.

Coincidentally this was the last time Murwillumbah played in Pennants on the Gold Coast, for some reason the GCDGA playing schedule changed to the same time the NRDGA played their matches and being loyal to the NRDGA we chose to play there.

This pennant reflects the result from a home and away final against a very strong Southport team who on handicap was incredibly strong by comparison but no one factored in the never give up and will to win attitude of the Murwillumbah team.

One story from the final – on the 10<sup>th</sup> hole, par 3, split level green, Graham Nelson sunk an extremely long putt to win the hole, a very irate opponent picked the ball out of the hole, tossed it back to him and said I'll bet you \$20 you can't do that again – the reply a very cool reply, "no need to" as he walked off the green, that my friends was mentally game set and match.

It was a great and unexpected win setting the platform for performances that followed. This was a team victory as everyone contributed to their maximum.
