



What's happening in 2026

1. Tee Times and tees.

Off one tee – 7 am to 9 am. At the end of each month, when there is a team game programmed, there will be a Shotgun start at 8 am allowing for players to stay for presentations, a wrap up of the month's program and a raffle.

2. Conditions of Play have been updated for 2026. Hard copies are available in locker room and electronically on the website. Ask the Match Committee if you have any questions. Note: No caddies are allowed on competition days.

3. Common Rules & Penalties Cards

R&A Rules of Golf 2023 is an excellent App for iPhone and iPad. Try it out! Please let the Match Committee know what you would like discussed in terms of updates on the rules and etiquette of the game. There are laminated cards available for the common rules and the etiquette rules are in your program book. (Take note of number 13) if anything comes up during your round that you weren't sure about, let us know and we can all learn from each other.

4. Eclectics, birdies, sand savers and royal chips.

These competitions will commence on Feb 3rd. All eclectic scores will be handled by the computer and reported on at the end of the year. Players will need to continue to complete and hand in the coloured slips for Sand Savers, Birdies and Royal Chips. Julie Connell will continue to keep a record of these and publish results each month.

DIVISIONS. So that the spread of players across the divisions is as even as possible, depending on numbers, players are organised in 1, 2 or 3 divisions based on their daily handicap.

5. Pace of play

We would like groups to monitor the time it takes your group to play your first 9 holes (2 hours 10 mins) and then 18 holes (4 hours 20 mins) so that you are aware how long it is taking you to play. Also did your group do what they should have in terms of good pace of play and did you keep pace with your place on the timesheet? When it comes down to it, just try and keep up with the group in front!

6. Nearest the Pins

There will be 2 NTP's for under 30 players, 6 NTP's for 30 plus players.

If you are in the final group of players, please remember to bring in the equipment on Holes 2, 8, 10 and 14 and give it to the Golf Shop.

Saturday players will now have a point score result, which will run separately from the weekday competition.

Winner - 15 pts, Second - 10 pts, Third - 5 pts.
