



2026 Men's Club Championships Conditions of Play

Followed by Member's Presentation Night (Saturday 26th September)

The men's club championships will be played over four rounds on the following dates:

Round 1 - Saturday 12th September (2T start – no social play)

Round 3 – Sunday 19th September (2T start)

Round 2 – Saturday 13th September (2T start – no social play)

Round 4 – Saturday 26th September (2T start)

The format of play will be 72 holes stroke play from the Blue Tees and 8 major prizes will be awarded as follows:

72 Hole Gross Club Champion	(H'cap +5-10)	\$400
72 Hole B Grade Gross Champion	(H'cap 11-15)	\$400
72 Hole C Grade Gross Champion	(H'cap 16-20)	\$400
72 Hole D Grade Gross Champion	(H'cap 21-45)	\$400
72 Hole Overall Nett Champion	(A, B, C & D Grades)	\$300 x 4
72 Hole Junior Veterans Gross Club Champion	(55-64 years)	\$200
72 Hole Senior Veterans Gross Club Champion	(>65 years)	\$200
36 Hole Junior Gross Club Champion (Rounds 3 & 4)	(<18 years)	\$100

- Open to all male, full financial members of Murwillumbah Golf Club.
- There are no max strokes during Club Championships
- All players must have played a minimum of 8 competition rounds to be eligible for the Club Championship Handicaps will be frozen from the first round however will change for each of the daily competitions.
- On Sunday 30th of August, players will be able to pre-register their preferred tee times for all four rounds by entering their names on the timesheet (no prepayment required, members only) as follows:

Rounds 1 & 2: @8:10am Sunday 30th August

Rounds 3 & 4: @8:20am Sunday 30th August

- If there is a tie for any gross event, there will be a 3-hole aggregate playoff from the 1st, 2nd and 3rd holes. If there is still a tie, the match committee will determine from which hole to continue play sudden death, until a winner is determined. Overall Nett Champion will be decided on a countback over the last 18 holes.
- The top 4 gross players in each grade are highly encouraged to play in a seeded draw for the fourth round, although this is not compulsory.
- Seeded draw tee times will be as follows: D Grade – 11:35, C Grade – 11:42, B Grade 11:49, A Grade – 11:56.
- A 36-hole Junior Championship will be held on the third and fourth rounds teeing off at 12:03pm each day.
- The R&A Rules of Golf and local rules of Murwillumbah Golf Club shall be the rules of play for the event. The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather, change the competition conditions. Any rules questions should be directed to the Pro Shop by calling 6672 4200.

- Following the final round (Saturday 26th September) there will be light food options provided and a Member's Presentation night for Ladies, Veteran's and men's major event winners for 2026!
